THE ITALIAN MINISTER OF HEALTH
in agreement with
THE PRESIDENT OF THE REGION OF LOMBARDY



HAVING REGARD TO article 32 of Law no. 833 of 23 December 1978;

HAVING REGARD TO article 117 of Legislative Decree no.112 of 31 March 1998;

RECALLING the Ordinance of 21 February 2020, adopted by the Minister of Health and by the President of the Region of Lombardy, containing urgent guidelines aimed at tackling the CODIV-19 epidemiological emergency;

HAVING REGARD TO Decree-Law no. 6 of 22 February 2020, containing "*Urgent measures regarding the containment and management of the CODIV-19 epidemiological emergency*";

HAVING REGARD TO the Decree of the Council of Ministers of 23 February 2020;

provides as follows

Without prejudice to the above-mentioned rules and ordinances regarding the Municipalities of Codogno, Castiglione D'Adda, Casalpusterlengo, Fombio, Maleo, Somaglia, Bertonico, Terranova dei Passerini, Castelgerundo and San Fiorano, as far as the remaining territory of the Region of Lombardy is concerned, the provisions contained in items c), d), e), f) and i) of article 1, paragraph 2 of Decree-Law no. 6 of 22 February 2020 shall apply, namely:

- c) the suspension of gatherings or initiatives of any kind, of any events and/or any type of meetings to be held in a public or private place, including those of cultural, recreational, sports and religious nature, even if these are held in enclosed places that are open to the public;
- d) the closure of kindergartens, childcare services and schools of all kinds and levels, as well as the interruption of school attendance and of any higher education activities, professional courses, master classes, courses for healthcare professions and universities for the elderly, with the exception of interns and trainees employed in the healthcare professions, with the exception of distance learning activities;
- e) the suspension of the opening hours of museums, cinemas and other cultural institutions and places referred to in article 101 of the Code of the Cultural Heritage and Landscape, pursuant to Legislative Decree no. 42 of 22 January 2004, as well as of the effectiveness of the regulatory provisions on free or open access to these institutions and places;
- f) the suspension of all educational trips, on both national and international territory;
- i) the obligation for any individual who entered Lombardy coming from areas of epidemiological risk, as identified by the World Health Organization, to give notice to the prevention department of the local jurisdiction health authority, which shall take care of informing the health authority in charge of adopting the fiduciary home stay measure with active surveillance;



With regard to item g) (suspension of insolvency proceedings and of the activities of public offices, without prejudice to the allocation of essential and public utility services), the application refers only to insolvency proceedings; special provisions will be identified, through a subsequent appropriate regional measure for front office services and for the regulation of meetings / gatherings.

With regard to point h) (application of the quarantine measure with active surveillance among individuals who have been in close contact with confirmed cases of diffusive infectious disease, for healthcare professionals and essential services), special provisions will be identified, through a subsequent appropriate regional measure.

With regard to point j) (closure of all business activities, except for those of public utility and essential public services referred to in articles 1 and 2 of Law no. 146 of 12 June 1990, including commercial establishments for the purchase of essential goods), business closings are arranged as follows:

- bars, night clubs and any other entertainment venue open to the public shall be closed from 6 pm to 6 am; further measures will be defined to avoid gatherings in such places;
- commercial establishments that are located within shopping centers and markets, except for grocery stores, shall be closed on Saturdays and Sundays;
- trade fairs shall be closed.

With regard to point k), business owners are invited to ensure appropriate precautionary measures.

The President of the Region of Lombardy, in agreement with the Italian Minister of Health, shall be entitled to change the provision contained in the present ordinance, due to any further epidemiological developments.

This ordinance shall be immediately effective throughout and including Sunday 1 March 2020, without prejudice to any further subsequent provisions.
